The A-10 is known for its range of weapons trained for destruction on it are 3 types of weapons:

- 1. fire arms
- 2. missiles
- 3. bombs

The most common thing on a A-10 is the gau-8 minigun that takes 30mm rounds. The gau-8 can shoot 72 rounds in 1 seconds so that means in 60 seconds 3,900 rounds can be shot, however, only 1350 rounds can be held at a time.

Missiles and bombs



One of the missiles used commonly is the AGM-65 Maverick. The mayerick ia a air-to-surface missile it is a commonly used munition for the A-10, targeted via electro-optical (TV-guided). Other weapons include <u>cluster bombs</u> and <u>Hydra</u> rocket pods. The A-10 is equipped to carry GPS and laser-quided bombs, such as the GBU-39 Small Diameter Bomb

History



The A-10 has a range of history just as big as its armory. It was built in 1976 for close air support. However it has been a jet to question with to the USAF. They wanted to try to put it out of service but due to its supperioness on the battlefield soldiers in operation desert storm want it to stay.

The A-10 was built as a 2 model of the republic P-47 thunderbolt, see how the name relates. They wanted to make a new model because of the P-47 superior strifing skills



The pilot has to do many checks on the rudder, ailerons, And flaps more than anything else. However, they do have to make a brief check on landing gear and missiles to check that they are armed. Meanwhile the crew is checking the gau-8 mini gun and sometimes reloading its 1350 capacity drum containers or changing its 7 barrels because due to the large rate of fire barrel section can melt causing blockage for the bullet and in some cases internal damage.
