How The Idea Of The Blimp Was Started


After the invention of the hot air balloon in 1783, a French officer named Meusnier envisioned an airship that utilized the design of the hot air balloon, but was able to be navigated.

So in the year 1783, there were two French Brothers (Jacques Etienne and Joseph Michel Montgolfier) created the hot air balloon and actually sent the first one ever 6000 ft (1800m) in the air which is incredible to hear in the 1700's!
